

ASET 2023 Conference Paper Submissions

Academic research papers on the conference themes will be accepted and those submitted will be peer-reviewed. Accepted and presented papers will be submitted for publication in the proceedings of ASET, which will be submitted to IEEE Xplore.

All submissions are to be as a full paper and should be in English. Abstract submissions are not accepted.

While preparing the manuscripts please follow the following instructions:

- Papers should be prepared using the IEEE style guide.
- If your paper has been prepared using Microsoft Word, please ensure that you have used the most current version which will help reduce word-to-pdf conversion issues such as embed-ded fonts, bookmarks, etc.
- Do not use page numbers or headers/footers
- Use non-zero PDF top and bottom margins to help indicate if there are any page numbers.

Additional Requirements:

If your paper is accepted for publication, you will need to adhere to the requirements of the conference proceedings publications and sign the copyright form.

Important Dates:


- Paper Submission Deadline: December 20, 2022
- Notification of Acceptance: January 20, 2023
- Camera Ready: January 31, 2023

Important Notes:


- At least one author per paper must be registered for the conference.
- The papers will be peer reviewed. We will reply to you with the decision regarding your paper within 30 days. If you do not hear from us within two months, please email the relevant conference chair.
- All papers are submitted through EDAS <u>https://edas.info/</u>. Submissions by email are not accepted.
- Papers not presented at ASET conferences will not be submitted for publication to the IEEE Xplore digital library.
- Papers that do not pass IEEE similarity crosscheck will not be submitted for publication to the IEEE Xplore digital library. Maximum allowed similarity is 30% in total and 10% from a single source.
- The submitted papers should be formatted using the template here. [IEEE Word Template]
- The copyright form should be filled and submitted using EDAS after the paper is accepted. EDAS will transfer the author automatically to the IEEE website, where the author can complete the copyright transfer form. If this step is not conducted, then the IEEE will not publish the accepted paper.

EDAS Guidelines

When you convert your paper, which is a Microsoft word file, to pdf, go to **Save As**, choose **pdf**, click **options**, then tick **ISO 19005**. See the screenshot below.



Remove any URL in the paper. For example, the paper below cannot be uploaded to EDAS since the email **mgdeisat@hct.ac.ae** is a URL.
