Dr. Shamma Alnaqbi Campus Executive Director, Zayed Military University

Throughout her career, Dr. Alnaqbi has held multiple strategic leadership roles, including Associate Dean and Program Chair of General Education at Rabdan Academy, Director of the Student Affairs Department, and Head of the Foundation Program at the Higher Colleges of Technology. Passionate about innovation in education, she is committed to advancing academic excellence and driving meaningful change across the UAE's education landscape. Driven by purpose, Dr. Alnaqbi believes that empowering minds is the foundation of a stronger nation.

Dr. Hanan Sukkar is a seasoned expert with over 29 years of experience in Child and Family Development, holding degrees from San Diego State University and the University of Melbourne. Dr. Alison Burrows is a professor and researcher of education and childhood studies at Middlesex University Dubai. She wrote and launched the first-ever Masters of Education Technology Integration and Practice degree in Dubai that focuses on meaningful learning with technology and digital well-being for students. Alison received her doctorate from Johns Hopkins University where she was a two-time merit scholar and research fellow. Her research focuses on the effects of screen time on the developing child, meaningful learning with technology, and teacher technology self-efficacy. Dr. Alison is also the founder of Dr. Alison Parenting, an organization that provides coaching and screen time consulting to parents. She uses 25 years of experience in child development and education by connecting parents and teachers to understand and leverage research and science to educate and raise resilient, confident, and happy children in the digital age.
