ASET 2026 Conference Paper Submissions

Academic research papers on the conference themes will be accepted, and all submitted papers will be peer-reviewed.

All submissions must be full papers and written in English. Abstract-only submissions are not accepted.

While preparing the manuscripts, please follow the instructions below:

- Papers should be prepared using the IEEE style guide.
- If your paper has been prepared using Microsoft Word, please ensure that you have used the most current version, which will help reduce Word-to-PDF conversion issues such as embedded fonts, bookmarks, etc.
- Do not use page numbers or headers/footers
- Use non-zero PDF top and bottom margins to help indicate whether there are any page numbers.
- The number of pages of the paper should not exceed eight pages.

If your paper is accepted for publication, you must adhere to the requirements of the conference proceedings publications and sign the copyright form.

Notification of Acceptance: **24 July 2026**

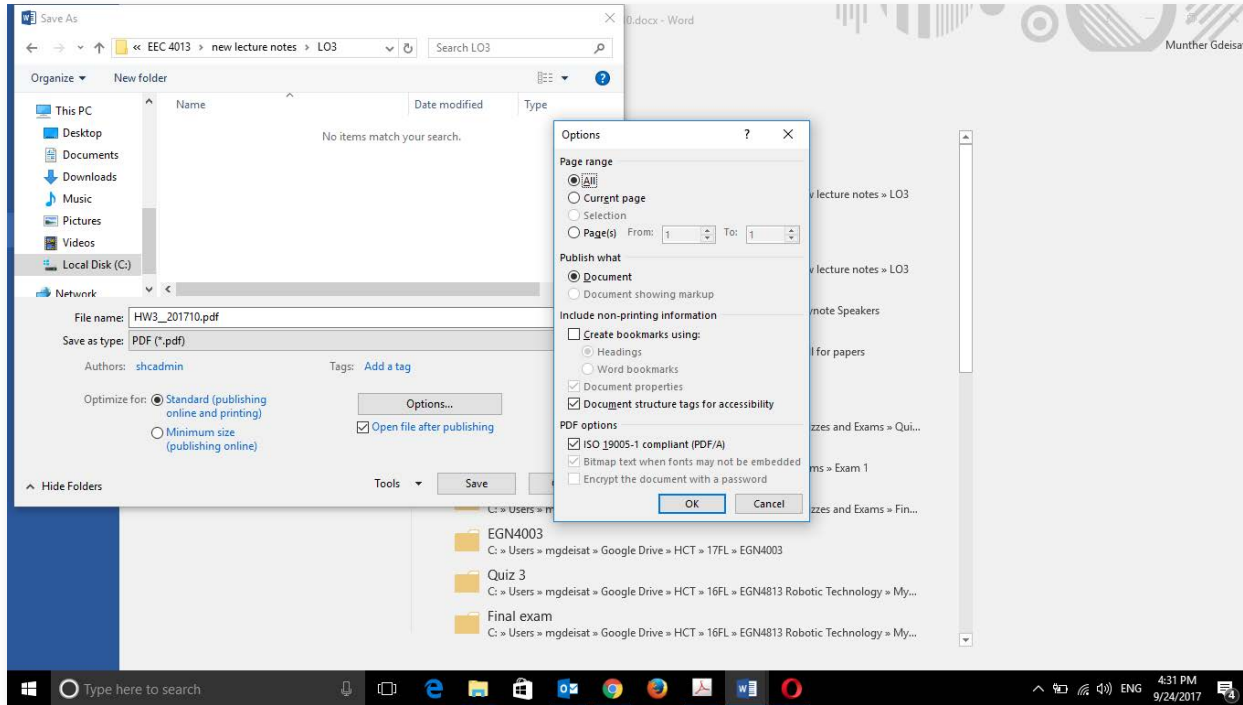

Important Notes:

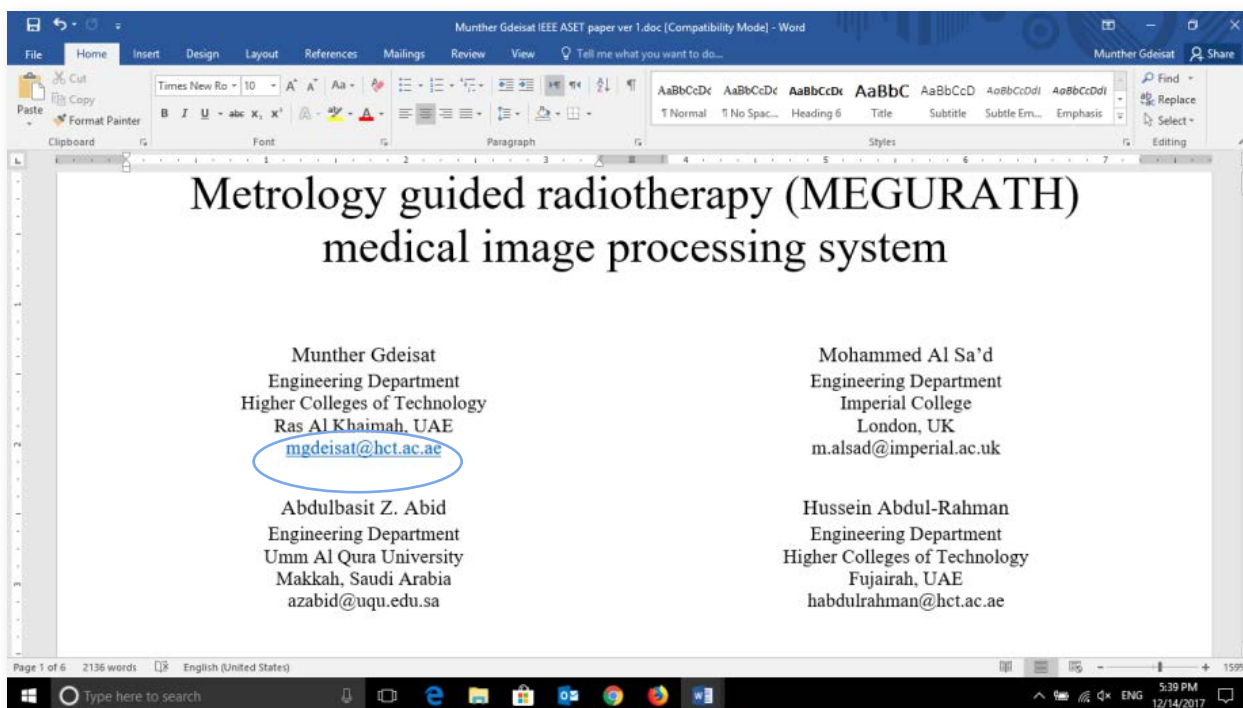
- At least one author must be registered for the conference.
- All papers will be peer-reviewed. We will reply to you with the decision regarding your paper within 30 days. If you do not hear from us within two months, please email the relevant conference chair.
- All papers must be submitted through EDAS (<https://edas.info/>). Submissions by email are not accepted.
- Papers not presented at ASET conferences will not be submitted for publication to the IEEE Xplore digital library.
- Papers that do not pass the IEEE similarity crosscheck will not be accepted. Maximum allowed similarity is 30% in total and 10% from a single source.
- The submitted papers should be formatted using the template here. [[IEEE Word Template](#)]
- The copyright form should be filled out and submitted using EDAS after the paper is accepted. EDAS will transfer the author automatically to the IEEE website, where the author can complete the copyright transfer form. **If this step is not completed, the IEEE will not publish the accepted paper.**

EDAS Guidelines

1. When you convert your paper (a Microsoft Word file) to PDF, go to Save As, choose PDF, click Options, then tick ISO 19005. See the screenshot below.



2. Remove any URL in the paper. For example, the paper below cannot be uploaded to EDAS since the email mgdeisat@hct.ac.ae is a URL.
